TOTEM PARK AND PLACE VANIER CLOSED DURING HOLIDAY/CHRISTMAS BREAK

PLANNING FOR THE UBC HOLIDAY/CHRISTMAS BREAK

As you make travel and other plans for the Holiday/Christmas Break, please remember Totem Park and Place Vanier residences will be closed during this time. Totem Park and Place Vanier close because of concern about so few residents staying alone in large empty buildings.

Residents must vacate by 12 noon on Wednesday, December 21, 2011.

Residence will re-open after 12 noon Monday, January 2, 2012. (Residence Contract Section 1.03)

Please plan accordingly.

Although residents are not permitted to reside in or have access to their room during this time, your belongings may remain in your room. Plan to take your important and valuable items with you, including your laptop, passport/visa, photo identification, bank/credit cards, medication and prescriptions, iPod, etc. Take your snowboard, skis, skates should there be any chance you'll get to use them.
